Final Exam: The Grammar Final Exam in English 0310 is optional. If you are satisfied with your grade after taking the last exam on the last day of class (Dec. 3), you will receive that grade as your official grade. If, on the last day of class, you are not satisfied with your grade, you must let the professor know during that day's class meeting and make an appointment to take the Grammar Final Exam the following week.

If the ENGL 0310 Final Exam is taken, it is averaged into the student's final grade average. Please note the Final Exam can raise or lower the final grade.

What class should be taken next? After a student successfully completes ENGL0310, the student must take the DW Departmental Final, the Writing Assessment, or the eAssessment.
